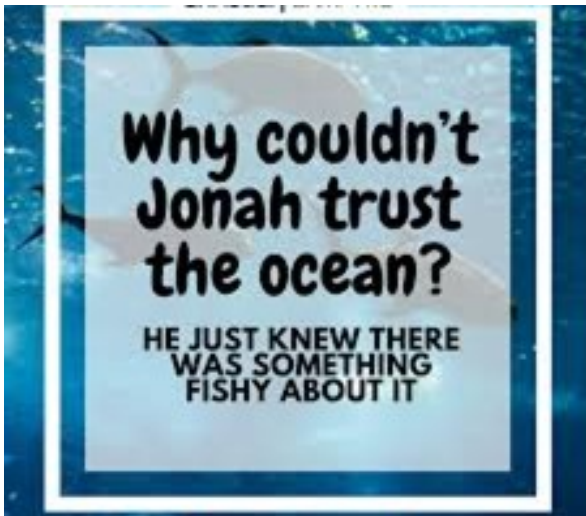

Romans 12:1-2

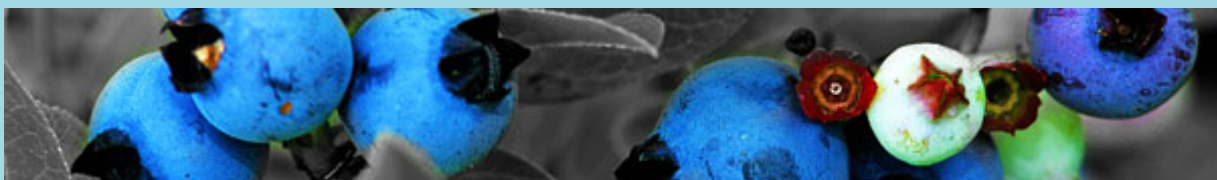

Recently, I've been in a few conversations regarding actual, in-person church attendance versus virtual church attendance. In thinking this through a bit, three thoughts have jumped out at me:

(1) We need our church family for their support, encouragement, and strength. This point has been reinforced when I reflect on a quote I read years ago: "Be kind, for everyone you meet is fighting a very hard battle."

(2) Our church family needs the gifts, talents, skills, and experiences that the Lord has blessed us with. Oftentimes it's hard to measure the kind of impact we have on the people around us.


(3) In order to grow spiritually so that we become even more effective in our ministry to others, regular connection to our church family includes the accountability that we all need. We need to be accountable to one another as we all strive toward perfection in Christ.

All three of these examples are far more impactful during in-person interactions as opposed to virtual church attendance. The devil knows quite well that keeping us isolated from one another makes us an easier target for his attacks. I can remember the pastor of the church we used to attend say that the devil has two main jobs...keep people from getting saved; if that's unsuccessful, keep Christ-followers from being effective. Let's spur one another on toward good works, for such a time as this.

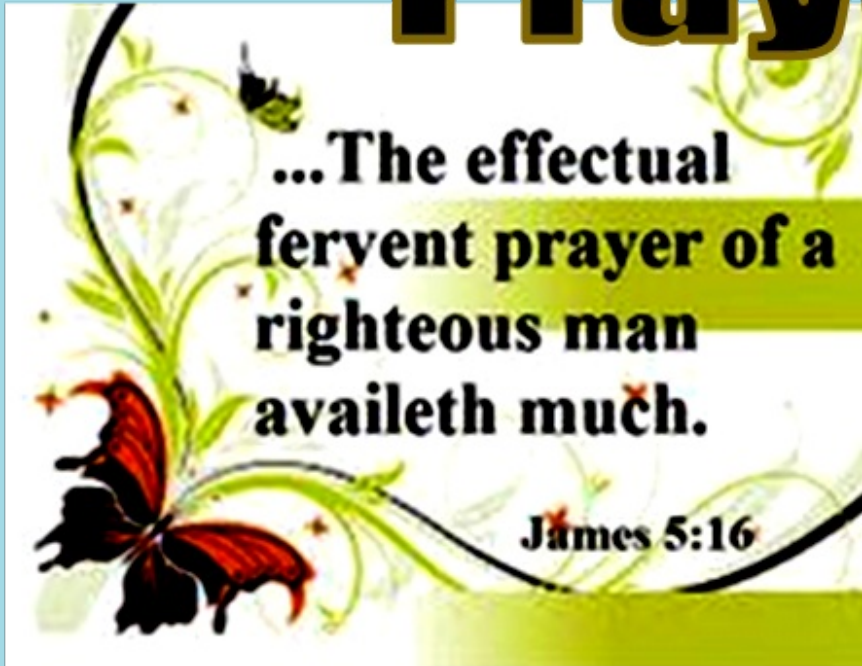
